You can prune the tree but once the sprouts grow, they'll fall off or start breaking. He recommends removing them completely. We may get another year or two, but it'll just have sprouts all over it. Council Member Paul Bohanan made a motion to remove Ash trees, China Berry tree, and dead branches behind City Hall, second by Council Member Ron Foster, vote was unanimous.
