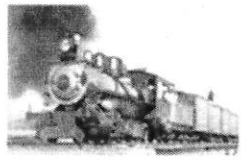

  - a. Citizen Remarks (Citizens who have signed up to speak prior to the meeting)
5. **Action and Other Items**
  - a. **SF-1 zoning district variance request from Samantha Kacir, on behalf of Jimmy Byrd,** to add farm and farm accessory building uses including non-commercial stables set back from the adjacent property lines a minimum distance of 75 feet and riding academy or other equestrian related activities. Discuss and take action.
  - b. **Time clock for city office** – would be beneficial to keep an online record of hours worked and it will be more useful as the city grows/needs more employees. Discuss and take action.
  - c. **Open and read any bids received for road repairs for the city.** Discuss and take action.
  - d. **Council Members to discuss and mark the locations of “No Thru Truck Traffic” signs** so Dennis Sikorski can get them installed. Once complete, City Secretary Veronica Garner will get a map of locations to Randy Stump so he can create an ordinance for them. – Discuss and take action.
  - e. **Municipal Court for the City** – In order to be able to enforce our ordinances, we need a Municipal Court (can be held at City Hall), a Judge (usually the Mayor or can be appointed), a Municipal Clerk (usually City Secretary), an Officer of Law, and a

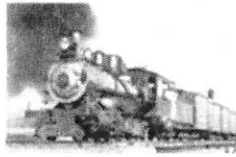


Prosecutor (could be our attorney, Randy Stump), that the City would employ. These positions would require continued yearly training, full time city office hours for ticket processing, etc, and possibly another employee in the office as Randy states, municipal courts are a lot to deal with. Do y'all want City Secretary to further look into this? – Discuss and take action.

- f. **Light pole by the Weir Store** – want bid to run electric over street or wait until we repair the road? Would be nice to have that working for Christmas time.
  - g. **PNC Bank (previously BBVA) Money Market Account** is charging a statement fee, went to change to online statements with a customer service agent and our account was inactive due to no activity for 3 months. He reactivated it so I can change statement type, but First Texas Bank does not charge a statement fee, has a better interest rate (0.02% vs 0.01%), and I can set up a \$1 automated deposit to keep the account active. Discuss and take action.
  - h. **Market Days** – want to make sure it's okay for a resident to set up and sell personal items as long as it's not junk. Ex: antiques, furniture, glassware, old signs, craft items, homemade goodies, etc. What is not allowed? Discuss and take action.
  - i. **5M Associates, City Engineer's Report & Updates.** None at this time.
  - j. **CBDG (Community Block Development Grant) Updates.** None at this time.
  - k. **Streets.** Discuss and take possible action.
6. **Discuss and other City business, and if need be, place on next Regular Meeting Agenda.**
7. **City Secretary updates or other info.** – Updating zoning map, updated city boundary map with census bureau including new annexations. Also creating a PDF of all stop sign locations so City Attorney can create an ordinance for us. Called Williamson County Sheriff about resident parking in the right of way at the house on the corner of FM 1105 and FM 971.
8. **Discuss and other City business, and if need be, place on next Regular Meeting Agenda.**
